<p>Portobello Road Gin, England 42.0% £4.80</p> <p>Dry and spicy, Juniper lead, it is big with nutmeg and citrus. Fever-Tree: Indian Tonic Garnish: Lime Zest</p>	<p>Jawbox Single Estate Classic Dry Gin 43.0% £5.10</p> <p>Ireland Belfast-made gin with black mountain heather, starting with classic juniper and citrus and then leading into pepper spice and root botanicals. Fever-Tree: Ginger Ale Garnish: Lime</p>
<p>Malfy Con Limone Gin, Italy 41.0% £4.80</p> <p>Italian gin using lemons from the Amalfi Coast and from the island of Sicily. Citrus fresh. Fever-Tree: Mediterranean Tonic Garnish: Lemon Zest</p>	<p>Fifty Pounds Gin, UK 43.5% £5.10</p> <p>Classic London dry gin, pine from the juniper and citrus from oranges and lemons. It has an exceptional long finish and fine balance throughout. Fever-Tree: Mediterranean Tonic Garnish: Basil</p>
<p>Sacred Pink Grapefruit, Italy 43.8% £5.20</p> <p>Using organic pink grapefruit from Spain and Italy. Fever-Tree: Mediterranean Tonic Garnish: Cardomom</p>	<p>Hendricks Gin, Scotland 41.4% £5.10</p> <p>One of the pioneers in the new gin craze, this Scottish gin uses rose petals as well as elderflower and chamomile to add a floral edge to the main cucumber freshness. Fever-Tree: Elderflower Tonic Garnish: Cucumber Slices</p>
<p>Wight Mermaids Gin, England 42.0% £5.20</p> <p>Smooth and refreshing with sweet peppery notes. Fever-Tree: Indian Tonic Garnish: Cucumber</p>	<p>Chase Elegant Gin, England 48.0% £5.40</p> <p>The base spirit comes from apples and there is no shortage of this flavour coming through the liquid. Elegant and crisp followed by warm spices and earthy undertones. Fever-Tree: Indian Tonic Garnish: Apple Slices</p>
<p>Brooklyn Gin, USA 40.0% £6.00</p> <p>Made in New York, they use fresh citrus peel and hand cracked juniper. Complex and flavourful. Fever-Tree: Indian Tonic Garnish: Basil</p>	<p>The Botanist Gin, Scotland 46.0% £5.80</p> <p>Nine classic botanicals as well as 22 local ones found on the island of Islay. This is a complex floral gin with an outstanding finish Fever-Tree: Elderflower Tonic Garnish: Thyme</p>
<p>Xoriguer - Mahon Gin, England 38.0% £4.80</p> <p>A base spirit made from grapes, it is complex, with a rich aromatic taste. Fever-Tree: Indian Tonic Garnish: Juniper Berry</p>	<p>Elephant Gin, Germany 45.0% £6.20</p> <p>With a list of botanicals that make it sound like a witch's spell, Lions, tail, Devil's claw, Wormwood to name but a few. This German made, African inspired gin delivers a herbal and earthy style. Fever-Tree: Indian Tonic Garnish: Apple Slices</p>
<p>Haymans Old Tom Gin, England 40.0% £4.80</p> <p>A style that dates back to the 1830's this is a London dry gin in terms of botanicals but with added sugar for a touch of sweetness Fever-Tree: Indian Tonic Garnish: Lime</p>	<p>Citadelle Gin, France 44.0% £5.40</p> <p>A French gin produced in the Cognac region. It has Juniper, orange, cardamom and sixteen other botanicals combine to give this liquid a dry peppery finish. Fever-Tree: Indian Tonic Garnish: Flamed Orange Zest</p>
<p>Da Mhile Seaweed Gin, Wales 42.0% £5.10</p> <p>Welsh gin infusing seaweed for three weeks prior to bottling. Fever-Tree: Elderflower Tonic Garnish: Lemon</p>	<p>Star of Bombay London Dry Gin 47.5% £5.40</p> <p>England A higher strength gin based on the Bombay Sapphire recipe but with added ambrette seeds and bergamot. This is a complex and subtle style of London dry gin with the added weight of the alcohol. Fever-Tree: Indian Tonic Garnish: Orange Zest</p>
<p>Four Pillars Rare Dry Gin, Australia 41.8% £6.20</p> <p>The use of antipodean botanicals imparts this gin with depth. The use of lemon myrtle gives the citrus some herbaceous notes not usually found here. Fever-Tree: Aromatic Tonic Garnish: Orange Twist</p>	
<p>Bulldog London Dry Gin, England 40.0% £4.20</p> <p>Slightly spicy on the palate, cinnamon and cardamom combine with the citrus leaving a warm lingering finish. Fever-Tree: Mediterranean Tonic Garnish: Black Pepper</p>	
<p>Gin Mare, Spain 48.0% £6.10</p> <p>Mediterranean gin, herbaceous on the nose with botanicals such as rosemary, thyme and olive. This is definitely a 'good' different. Fever-Tree: Mediterranean Tonic Garnish: Basil</p>

Monkey 47 Schwarzdald Dry Gin 47.0% £7.20
Germany

Forty seven botanicals in this German-born gin. The recipe boasts that one third of these come directly from the Back Forest region. The name is in memory of Max the monkey who lived at Berlin zoo after the 2nd word war.

Fever-Tree:Mediterranean Tonic | Garnish:Mint

Oxley Gin, England 47.0% £6.20

Sixteen botanicals in total, this London dry style is vivacious. Juniper and grapefruit dominate but rounded with other citrus and floral notes.

Fever-Tree:Indian Tonic | Garnish:Black Pepper

Plymouth Sloe Gin, England 26.0% £4.20

All the seven botanicals of Plymouth dry gin with the addition of sloe berries. The palate is fruity, smooth and full bodied - the perfect balance between sweet and dry.

Fever-Tree:Lemon Tonic | Garnish:Lemon Slice

Williams Seville Orange Gin, England 40.0% £5.20

Apple is the base to this gin but Seville orange is the definite flavour note. Marmalade to begin with and a touch of sweetness moving across to a pleasant dry finish.

Fever-Tree:Indian Tonic | Garnish:Grapefruit

Daffy's Gin, Scotland 43.4% £5.20

A mixture of old and new botanicals here, strong bodied with many levels of freshness. Notes of citrus, mint, toffee, caramel and chocolate all underpinned with the woody character of the juniper.

Fever-Tree:Elderflower Tonic | Garnish:Blueberries

Death's Door Gin, USA 47.0% £5.20

Getting it's name from a body of water just off Washington Island, this American gin uses just three botanicals. Showcasing just how complex a simple mix can be. Juniper pine, coriander citrus and a touch of sweetness from the fennel combine perfectly.

Fever-Tree:Mediterranean Tonic | Garnish:Juniper Berries

Junipero - Small Batch Gin, USA 49.3% £6.20

The first of two San Francisco produced gin on this list but made in true London dry style. Very juniper lead and with the addition of both citrus and spice, it all brings the 49.3% power together perfectly.

Fever-Tree:Indian Tonic | Garnish:Coriander

Brockmans Premium Gin, England 40.0% £6.20

a berry fruit driven gin, expect a lot of blackberry and blueberry notes to shine through.

Fever-Tree:Indian Tonic | Garnish:Blueberries

Sipsmith London Dry Gin, England 41.6% £5.20

London Dry style gin, Juniper and citrus holds the main flavour profile, liquorice and coriander balance the liquid perfectly.

Fever-Tree:Indian Tonic | Garnish:Lime Wedge

No 209 Premium, USA 46.0% £5.20

San Francisco produced also, this is certainly citrus lead but not overpoweringly so. The bergamot orange clearly shines though but it is anchored by the cassia bark and coriander seed warmth. Juniper is noticeable but in more of a subtle way than London dry styles.

Fever-Tree:Indian Tonic | Garnish:Coffee Beans

Tarquins Gin, UK 42.0% £5.20

Juniper is prevalent but strong lemon, orange and violets come through as well. This gin is very smooth and balances the earthiness and citrus harmoniously.

Fever-Tree:Elderflower Tonic | Garnish:Lavender Stem

Berkeley Square Gin Limited Release 46.0% £5.20
England

Produced in Warrington under the Greenall's portfolio, this premium gin uses basil and lavender to offer such an interesting herbaceous style gin.

Fever-Tree:Indian Tonic | Garnish:Basil

Tanqueray No. 10, England 47.3% £5.20

The Rolls Royce of gins. This perfectly created gin offers fresh juniper berries alongside zingy grapefruit, orange and lemon - the difference being that Tanq 10 use whole fruits and not the zest as many others do.

Fever-Tree:Mediterranean Tonic | Garnish:Grapefruit

Bathtub Gin, England 43.3% £5.20

Tipping its cap to the bath tub style, it is cold compounded meaning that no distillation takes place. 6 botanicals are steeped for an ever changing amount of time until the right flavour profile is created. Smooth, earthy styled gin.

Fever-Tree:Mediterranean Tonic | Garnish:Orange Twist

Edinburgh Gin Raspberry Liqueur 20.0% £5.20
Scotland

Edinburgh gin with added cane spirit and of course - raspberries. Sweet and tartness in one.

Fever-Tree:Elderflower Tonic | Garnish:Raspberries

Edinburgh Gin's Rhubarb & Ginger 20.0% £5.20
Liqueur,Scotland

Edinburgh gin infused with rhubarb and ginger, sweet and sharp balance with warmth from the ginger flowing through.

Fever-Tree:Lemon Tonic | Garnish:Lemon Slice

Gordon's Sloe Gin, England 26.0% £5.20

Blackberries and cloves combine as Gordon's original gin is steeped with sloe berries. Sweet but slightly tart, this sloe gin is not as heavy as the Plymouth style and is more approachable for those trying sloe gin for the first time.
